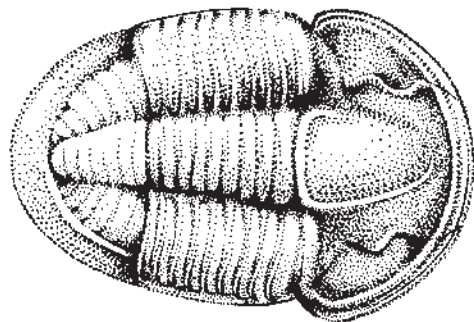


# UTAH FRIENDS OF PALEONTOLOGY
